Phyllis shared the Rule 20 reporting document. Completion of this report is primarily Tony's responsibility, with Phyllis assisting this summer.

Tim asked for clarification about Webfocus and faculty. Will faculty be expected to process and gather data from webfocus themselves? Bob explained that they won't be creating templates, just generating reports. Time spent in the next folio sessions should have faculty get a picture of how Webfocus will assist in the reporting process.

Phyllis shared UNO's Webfocus report request form. We do not need this type of form at this time because we are way beyond that point. She also shared UNO's timeline since they are next in line for a review. They will be sending their template as a sample. They will have their state review in July and their NCATE visit in November. They plan to use their tables from the folios for NCATE as well.

Folio reviewers are needed. Pat Arneson had volunteered to do this.

We have not gotten a deadline for our folios yet. State reps will be here with NCATE. Dates should be locked in soon.

Legislative bills dealing with education issues were discussed. Changes have been proposed in the Attracting Excellence to Teaching Scholarship.

Teacher World was discussed. Is there any follow up data available on those participants?

Rule 21 changes were discussed.

Tim will create a cover letter (email) for the alumni and administrator surveys. Frank Adams will handle this project.

Tim has not gotten a response from John Dunning regarding progress on the graduate program data collection.

Jim showed a Webfocus demo of the disposition survey.
